Dear Parents and Guardians,

Grade Primary will be doing online learning on Friday, September 25th. One student in the class has been recommended by 811 to have a Covid Test. There is currently only 1 active Covid-19 case in Nova Scotia, in the Western area. This active case is the result of travel and has been isolated. There has been a cold virus also going around but if you are experiencing cold symptoms you will be recommended to call 811 to receive further instructions.

As a precaution and to ensure the safety of our students, it is LSK policy to transition to online learning while awaiting the Covid-19 test results of a student in the class. Please self-monitor your child(ren) for Covid-19 symptoms. Call 811 for assessment if in the past 48 hours you have had, or you are currently experiencing:

Fever (i.e. chills/sweats) **OR** Cough (new or worsening)

OR

Two or more of the following symptoms (new or worsening):

Sore throat

Runny nose/nasal congestion

Headache

Shortness of breath

You will receive instructions for online/at home learning from the Primary teacher, Sheri Julian-Brooks. As we receive more information, we will update parents and guardians regarding Monday, September, 28th.
